UPON VISITING THE KNEPP CASTLE ARCHIVES, ONE IS CONFRONTED BY SHELF UPON SHELF OF NUMBERED BOXES WITH NO VISIBLE MEANS OF ASCERTAINING THEIR CONTENTS. THE WEST SUSSEX RECORDS OFFICE HAD PRODUCED A BASIC LIST OF BURRELL MANUSCRIPTS, COLLATED TOGETHER UNDER ACQUISITION NUMBERS, WHICH HAS BEEN PUBLISHED ON THE INTERNET, BUT EVEN THIS IS OF LITTLE ASSISTANCE IN ENABLING THE RESEARCHER TO DETERMINE WHICH BOX AN ITEM REQUIRED WAS STORED IN.

IN SEPTEMBER 2011, TWO MEMBERS OF THE HORSHAM DISTRICT ARCHAEOLOGY GROUP SAT DOWN AND RE-LISTED THE COLLECTION, BOX BY BOX, USING THE WSRO LISTING AS THE BASE RECORD, AND THIS DOCUMENT IS THE RESULT OF THAT ENDEAVOUR, COPIES OF WHICH MAY BE FOUND IN THE ARCHIVE ROOM FOR THE USE OF THE RESEARCHER.

The writing looks ancient but was the formal hand used by the clerks in these courts. It's dated the day after the feast of St Martin (11 Nov 1629) – but may be up to week later. John Wright and his wife Mary convey to Robert Emery 20 acres of land, 20 acres of pasture in South Malling and Cliffe at Lewes.

It is usually found in association with a more recognisable form of conveyance – but since it is here in the Burrell Mss on its own and un-associated with anything, then it looks as though it must be a stray.
